News & Notes

- Setting the Stage: USF enters the 2019 NAIA DII National Championship as the No. 8 seed in the Liston Bracket. The Saints' first-round opponent will be the Liston Bracket's top seed, No. 2 Oklahoma Wesleyan University.
- Survive and Advance: St. Francis' season shifted to "survive and advance" mode well before making the trek to Sioux Falls. The Saints are winners of four straight elimination games, culminating in the program's first CCAC Tournament title since 1996.
- Persevering Underdogs: USF is comfortable in the underdog role, having been on the brink of elimination multiple times against higher seeds during its current four-game winning streak. Needing a win in the regular season finale just to qualify for the CCAC Tournament, Terrion **Howard** hit a game-tying 30-footer at the regulation buzzer in a 90-81 overtime victory over St. Ambrose. Howard provided more heroics against the CCAC Tournament's top seed, Olivet Nazarene, in the first round, hitting two go-ahead free throws in the final seconds of an 81-80 win. The Saints then edged Roosevelt (68-63) and Governors State (59-54) on the road to claim the title as the eighth and final seed.
- Sound Familiar?: USF last reached the NAIA national stage in 2016 when the Saints entered the field as a No. 1 seed. That year, USF fell to York College (Neb.), a No. 8 seed that needed a February run to qualify for the tournament. The Panthers carried their momentum into March, knocking out the Saints on their way to the NAIA quarterfinals.
- Scouting the Saints: USF's 59-54 win over Governors State was the Saints' first victory when scoring in the 50s this season. St. Francis spent much of the year most comfortable when totaling at least 80 points (14-2 record). One of the keys to the Saints' late February run has been success at the 3-point line both offensively and defensively. During its current four-game streak, USF is outscoring its opponents 99-54 from beyond the arc and limiting its foes to just 18 of 72 (25 percent) from distance.
- USF Players to Watch: Leading scorer Terrion Howard (12.8 points per game) was the only USF player to reach double figures in all four of the Saints' elimination games, while Pietro Badalassi did so in the three CCAC Tournament wins. Malik Bailey (honorable mention) and **Lewis Holey** (Newcomer of the Year) joined Howard (second-team) on the CCAC's honor roll.
- Scouting the Eagles: Oklahoma Wesleyan's only losses came to KCAC opponents Southwestern (twice) and Ottawa. The KCAC Regular Season Champions were denied a conference tournament title by Southwestern 78-75 on February 25. OKWU's statistical rankings show why they are 30-3 and No. 2 in the nation. The Eagles rank at or near the top of NAIA DII in many categories, including rebounding margin (+13.8, 1st), field goal percentage defense (.388, 2nd), scoring margin (+18.2, 3rd), 3-pointers made (11.9 per game, 5th) and scoring offense (89.6 points per game, 10th).
- **OKWU Players to Watch:** The Eagles have six players averaging at least nine points per contest. KJ Malveau is the team's leader in points (14.5 per game) and assists (3.6 per contest), while second-leading scorer Joshua Wilchombe (13.1 points per game) is also one of the nation's top per-game rebounders (9.4) and shot blockers (1.5).
