News & Notes

- Setting the Stage: USF can reach its third straight NAIA National Tournament Quarterfinal with a win on Friday against No. 3 Dakota Wesleyan. St. Francis is 6-3 on the NAIA national stage over the past four seasons, reaching the semifinals in 2017 and the quarterfinals in
- How We Got Here: The Saints never trailed in a 73-63 first-round win over Milligan on Thursday. The Buffaloes pulled within one point on two occasions, but USF locked in each time, extending its advantage back to double digits. Dakota Wesleyan outscored St. Thomas (Fla.) 49-23 in the first half on its way to a 31-point first-round win.
- Experienced Saints: Seven of USF's 10 players that saw the court on Thursday had national tournament experience. Those players are Ivana Markovic, Nichole Davidson, Kaitlin Aylward, Madi Canady, Andriana Acosta, Leah Sims, and Paige Gieseke.
- Last Meeting: Earlier this season, then No. 1 Dakota Wesleyan earned a 74-51 win over USF at the West Palm Beach Invitational. The Saints got off to a strong start on the defensive end, holding the Tigers (15-1) without a point for nearly six minutes on their way to a 10-4 advantage. DWU quickly flipped the script in the second quarter, outscoring USF 24-6 on its way to a double-digit lead at the break. The Tigers capitalized on St. Francis' miscues in the final three quarters, turning 19 USF giveaways into 22 points on their way to the victory.
- Scouting the Saints: St. Francis is 14-3 since the calendar turned to 2019. The Saints boast the fifth-stingiest defense in NAIA DII, holding its opponents to just 55.9 points per game. USF is also one of the top all-around shooting teams, ranking seventh in field goal percentage (.450), 25th in free throw shooting (.734) and 34th in 3-point percentage (.331).
- USF Players to Watch: Kaitlin Aylward poured in 28 points, a career-high at the national tournament, during Wednesday's win over Milligan. She came into the game averaging 15.1 points in her first seven career NAIA tournament games. Aylward combined with her fellow starting forwards, **Nichole Davidson** and **Jordan Pyle**, to post 55 of USF's 73 points. St. Francis' motion offense was sharp, finding cutters for layups and only turning the ball over four times.
- Scouting the Tigers: Dakota Wesleyan is one of the top offensive teams in the nation. The Tigers rank first in NAIA DII in free throw percentage (.828), third in shooting percentage (.463) and 10th in scoring (79.5 points per game). DWU also thrives on turnovers. This season, the Tigers have a +4.6 turnover margin (10th in the nation).
- DWU Players to Watch: Rylie Osthus, Kynedi Cheeseman and Sarah Carr combined for 63 of Dakota Wesleyan's points on Thursday, while shooting 23 of 37 from the floor (62.2 percent). Those three players are joined by Makaela Karst as Tigers with double-digit scoring averages. Osthus also ranks 10th in the nation in assists per game (5.3).


